Dear members,

In this Newsletter we would like to give you more information about the first talk in the New Year. On **Sunday afternoon at 3 pm, 17 January 2016 Mrs Angeline Bremer-Cox will be speaking to us on Sculpture for a Modern World**. This is the title of the exhibition of the works of sculptress Barbara Hepworth which is at the Museum Kröller Müller until 17 April 2016.

## THE TALK

The Kröller Müller Museum honours Barbara Hepworth (Wakefield 1902- St Ives 1975) with a major retrospective, fifty years after her last major exhibition in 1965. Barbara Hepworth is one of the most successful sculptors of the twentieth century. Her works are included in the world's great sculpture collections.



Barbara Hepworth made her debut in the art world in the 1920s. At that time she made abstracted figures of people and animals, carved from marble and local English stone. She soon joined the international avant-garde and visited the studios of Pablo Picasso, Georges Braque, Jean Arp and Constantin Brancusi in Paris. Her work became increasingly abstract. From 1933 on, she began creating her characteristic organic forms, in which she literally breaks open the closed form. In 1939, Barbara Hepworth moved to St. Ives in Cornwall. The landscape then became an important source of inspiration for her work.

The exhibition follows Hepworth's career, from the stone sculptures of her early years to her later, celebrated bronze pieces. The exhibition includes exceptional, never previously shown works, such as fabric designs, drawings, collages and photographic material from Hepworth's personal archive.

### THE SPEAKER

Drs. A. Bremer-Cox is associated expert with the Kröller Müller Museum and has studied history of art. After her studies she was master at the "Vrije Academie". For 9 years she was a curator and produced several exhibitions and publications. She also produces short documentaries, for instance Vincent van Gogh's vision on his life and art. (2004) Angeline is cultural entrepreneur, head of the department for guided tours of the Kröller Müller Museum.

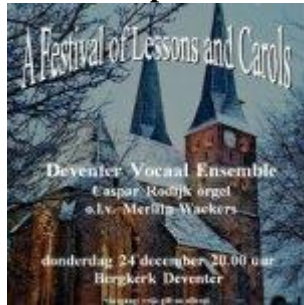
